



## FRINGE PARKING & FREE TROLLEY SERVICE

**Stadium Park-and-Ride**

Just off Route 50 on the right side of Rowe Boulevard, you'll find the U.S. Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium Park-and-Ride lot. Parking is available for visitors at all times except during USNA football games on select Saturdays in the autumn and Commissioning Day in May.

All tour buses are required to park here as well. Frequent FREE Annapolis Transit shuttle buses provide transportation to and from the Stadium, Downtown, Naval Academy and West Annapolis.

## TWO FREE SHUTTLE ROUTES TAKE YOU ALL AROUND THE DOWNTOWN AREA

**Navy Blue Route:** Serves the Visitors Center, US Naval Academy Gate One, City Dock, Main Street and West Annapolis. Departs the Stadium on the hour and half-hour from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays, and on weekends between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.

**State Shuttle:** Express service to the Visitors Center and Church Circle. Departs the Stadium weekdays only, every 5 minutes during rush hours; 10-15 minutes mid-day and evenings between 6:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**Taxis:** Sedans, limos and 12-passenger vans operate in Annapolis as licensed, metered taxicabs. Locate them in the phone directory under "taxicabs". Fares should be based on the meter, plus surcharges.

**Water Taxis:** Seasonal passenger ferry service on Spa Creek and Back Creek stops at City Dock, Eastport, Truxtun Park and other places. Call 410.263.0333 or "water taxi" on marine VHF Channel 68.

**Gold Routes A & B:** The Gold A bus travels clockwise, Gold B counter-clockwise, seven days a week. Both serve hotels, historic sites, restaurants and shops. Each trip is \$.75 and you may take your bike along, free. Transfers are also free to other local routes. Leave your car if you're staying at any hotel shown on the map and listed in this brochure.

## DOWNTOWN GARAGES AND PARKING LOTS

City Garages are fully staffed and secure, open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Reserved handicapped spaces are designated at ground-floor accessible entrances. Motorcycles, vans and limos are prohibited. Maximum vehicle height is 6'. Parking lots accommodate oversized vehicles.
