Amendment #1

Mr. Gary Elson wrote a memorandum in which he questioned whether the Special Meeting of December 18th, 2008 was called in accordance with applicable provisions of Charter. See Art. IV, Sec. 4(b): Mayor may call a special meetings of council; (d) upon written request of five members of the council, mayor shall convene the council.

Amendment #2

Strike line “No action taken” and substitute:

“Mr. Kling reported that he had filed the proper paper work concerning his pro bono work and that he expected to be reinstated as a member in good standing of the Bar by the Court of Appeals. The Mayor reported that she had asked the Attorney General’s Office to review representation of the city during the time that Mr. Kling was not a member in good standing of the Bar to determine if there was any doubt as to the validity of actions undertaken on behalf of the city by Mr. Kling.” Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and adopted, the meeting was adjourned at 3:25 p.m.
